Milan Bergamo Airport awards the last passenger to depart in 2018 and ends the year with an increase of 4.9%

The last passenger to depart from Milan Bergamo Airport in 2018 boarded a Blue Air flight to Bacau and took off at 20:40 on 31 December. Daniel Gheorghiu, Romanian, was the last to arrive at the check-in desk for the airline, completing the list of booked passengers and discovering that his was the last boarding card issued by the airport for the last flight of the year.

The passenger was awarded with a voucher for a return flight, courtesy of the airline Blue Air and valid for one of the destinations served by Milan Bergamo Airport, as well as a VIP card for access to the VIP lounges, courtesy of SACBO.

For Milan Bergamo Airport, 2018 ended with an increase of over 600 thousand passengers compared to the 12 million 331 thousand recorded in 2017, corresponding to an increase of 4.9% for the year, reaching just under 13 million.

This result consolidates the third place held by Milan Bergamo Airport for number of passengers in the rankings of Italian airports, right behind Rome Fiumicino and Milan Malpensa.
