THE WORK-GROUP OF EUROPEAN AIRPORTS MEETS IN BERGAMO

On Thursday 10 and Friday 11 October, SACBO and Milan Bergamo Airport are playing host to the **Training Manager Benchmark for Aviation Safety**, a meeting that brings together training managers for security in the main European airports.

The group was set up in Brussels in 2018 and its purpose is to keep the airports involved constantly informed and in line with regards to normative updates relative to Regulation EU 139/2014, which concerns the assessment of competence for all personnel authorised to work unaccompanied in the airside zone of the airport, in other words the area to which access is subject to security control.

This activity of supervision and monitoring, which is generally under the control of the human resources manager of the airport management company, calls for a series of monitoring instruments that come together under the umbrella term "proficiency check".

In regard to this theme SACBO, in collaboration with the Università Cattolica of Brescia, has published a book that summarises the methodology used in response to the previsions of Regulation EU 139. This is the first work on the subject on a European level and sees Milan Bergamo Airport as a forerunner in the application of the relative regulation.
