

## SUNDAY 1st SEPTEMBER THE FIRST FLIGHT BETWEEN MILAN BERGAMO AND LONDON GATWICK OPERATED BY BRITISH AIRWAYS

Countdown to the return of **British Airways** with a scheduled flight to Milan Bergamo Airport. **The new route with London Gatwick will be inaugurated on Sunday 1st September with the arrival of the first aircraft scheduled at 18:40 at Milan Bergamo Airport, from which it will depart at 20:05. The following day, Monday 2 September, the flight is expected at 10.10 am at Milan Bergamo Airport departing for London Gatwick set at 11:00.** 

The route between Milan Bergamo Airport and London Gatwick will operate every day except for Saturdays, served by a 177-seater Airbus 320. From 7 December 2019 the flight will become daily with the addition of Saturday.

The official entry of British Airways into the Milan Bergamo Airport network adds opportunities to reach London, with Gatwick airport offering an additional range of international and intercontinental destinations.

"The presence of the most important UK airline is one of prestige and assigns an even more important role to our airport in the world of air transportation – said Giacomo Cattaneo, the Director of Aviation for SACBO, the company managing Milan Bergamo Airport - The opening of the route to London Gatwick airport permits the creation of a connection of significant logistic importance with the vast and important area to the south of the capital, offering convenient flight opportunities to passengers headed for the United Kingdom, particularly those from the extensive section of the population to the east of Milan, and to the residents on the catchment area of the second most important British airport, which is only 45 km from London and also ideal for reaching the many cities on the south coast of England. Another advantage is provided by the flight schedules, which have been studied to respond to the various requirements of the passengers".

"As our network expands we continue to add new, exciting routes and our service between Gatwick and Milan Bergamo is a great example of this - Paolo De Renzis, Commercial Manager of Corporate Sales for Europe British Airways, said - We hope customers will make the most of the six flights a week to London, and that those travelling from Gatwick will enjoy the lakes and skiing opportunities that Milan Bergamo opens up."
