MILAN BERGAMO AIRPORT REACHES THE 10-MILLION PASSENGER MARK

The progressive target was reached and passed on the afternoon of 19 September

Milan Bergamo Airport reached the 10-million passenger mark in the early afternoon of Thursday 19 September, one month earlier than in 2018, which then closed with an overall total at the end of December of 12 million, 938 thousand 572.

The growing trend in traffic since the beginning of the year is 5.8% which, if confirmed in the months to come, will lead Milan Bergamo Airport to consolidate its third place in the rankings of Italian airports, with a final forecast total of 13.6 million passengers.

Milan Bergamo Airport reached and exceeded the ten-million-passenger mark for the first time in December 2015, reaching over 11 million the following year and 12 million in 2017.
