

AN INCREASE IN FLIGHTS AND DESTINATIONS FROM MILAN BERGAMO AIRPORT

Exactly one month on from the recommencement of scheduled passenger flights at Milan Bergamo Airport, which took place on 18 May with the restoring of the first in a series of routes that Wizz Air is carrying forward, on the morning of Thursday 18 June Volotea inaugurated the route to Olbia (take off at 9:50 a.m., landing at Costa Smeralda airport at 11:15 a.m.), which will initially see five flights per week, every day from Thursday to Monday inclusive, with up to two flights daily in July and August.

From 20 June, and for all the summer weekends, Saturday and Sunday, Volotea will be flying from Milan Bergamo to Lampedusa and Pantelleria.

On Sunday 21 June Ryanair will recommence operations from Milan Bergamo Airport with the first seven routes to Madrid, Ibiza, Manchester, Palma de Mallorca, Athens, Catania and Alghero. For the last week of June, Ryanair will be running 11 daily flights from Milan Bergamo, moving on to guaranteeing 40% of its network from the airport as of 1 July.

In the check-in area and inside the terminal right up to the gates, SACBO has set up a new type of floor markings for physical distancing, and the self-drop-off service for checked luggage will once again be available as of Sunday 21 June.
