## Albastar launches direct flights from Milan Bergamo to Dakar.

Two weekly non-stop connections to Senegal.

Palma de Mallorca, 13.04.2022 – Albastar announces the start of scheduled operations from Italy to **Senegal**, with a twice-weekly flight departing from **Milan Bergamo to Dakar**, operated by 189-seat Boeing 737-800 aircraft.

The first connections will begin on Friday 13 May and Monday 16 May, with non-stop flights departing from Italy every **Monday and Wednesday, from June until 31 October**.

## Flight schedule from Bergamo to Dakar

Every Monday and Wednesday departing from Milan Bergamo at 11:15 p.m. and arriving in Dakar at 05:10 a.m.

## Flight schedule from Dakar to Bergamo

Every Tuesday and Thursday departing from Dakar at 06:40 a.m. and arriving in Milan Bergamo at 12:20 p.m.

"The reopening of the Dakar route offers a long-awaited travel opportunity for the Senegalese community, which is appreciably large in the province of Bergamo and more widely afield in Lombardy and in the areas from which Bergamo airport is easily accessible by means of motorway links", said **Giacomo Cattaneo**, Director of Commercial Aviation at SACBO. "This is a very popular route, in part due to the economic and commercial ties between northern Italy and Senegal. In addition, the direct connection with Dakar, with the flight covering a distance of approximately 4,300 km, is once again the longest-haul flight departing from Milan Bergamo airport".

excellent results in terms of traffic. Moreover, we are now the airport's leading leisure carrier with 15 destinations served during the summer season. The new long-haul flight to Dakar could be just the start of more extensive projects towards the North-West African area".
