NILE AIR INAUGURATES THE ROUTE BETWEEN CAIRO AND MILAN BERGAMO

Friday 28 June 2024. The Egyptian airline **Nile Air** has inaugurated the new route between Cairo and Milan Bergamo. The route is operated with an Airbus A320 with 8 Business-Class seats and 156 Economy-Class seats, and offers three weekly flights on Wednesdays, Fridays and Sundays, departing from Bergamo at 9.20 p.m. and arriving in Cairo at 2 a.m. the next day. The flight from Cairo leaves at 5.10 p.m. and arrives at Milan Bergamo at 8.10 p.m. The inaugural flight was welcomed with the traditional water salute performed by the Fire Brigade at Orio al Serio.

The route between Cairo and Milan Bergamo is the first ever to be operated by Nile Air in Italy, which has become the ninth country to be served by the Egyptian airline. Founded in Cairo in 2006, Nile Air is the largest private airline in Egypt and has been recognised as the 4th best regional airline in Africa by the Skytrax World Airline Awards.

The ceremony held at Milan Bergamo airport for the inaugural flight saw the presence of Mohammed El Sherif, the CCO of Nile Air, Manlio Olivero and Patrizia Ribaga, respectively the president and managing director of Global GSA, the company representing Nile Air in Italy, Dario Nanna representing commercial aviation management for SACBO and Nicola Lamera, the CEO of BGY International Services, the handling company part of the SACBO Group.
