**MILAN BERGAMO AIRPORT CELEBRATES ITS 12  
MILLIONTH PASSENGER OF 2017**

Milan Bergamo Airport has celebrated its 12-millionth passenger of 2017, a new annual record, resulting in the current year closing with over one million passengers more than 2016, which closed with 11 million 160 thousand.

The 12-millionth passenger of 2017 was the 23-year-old Chiara Filipponi, a clinical psychology degree student resident in Carnate (in the province of Monza Brianza), who flew from Bergamo to Lisbon with Ryanair.

She received a commemorative plaque, the Vip Card, a voucher for a flight from Milan Bergamo Airport, and a commemorative t-shirt, which was also worn by all of the airport personnel, and a special Christmas decoration, which was given to all of the passengers present in the airport, bearing the words “12 million passengers, also thanks to me”, underlining the general contribution to the reaching of this epic goal.

The passenger Chiara Filipponi was presented with her awards by Emilio Bellingardi, the Director General of SACBO, Giacomo Cattaneo, the Aviation Director of SACBO, and John Alborante, the Sales & Marketing manager for Ryanair in Italy.
