## MILAN BERGAMO AIRPORT: +5.7% PASSENGERS IN THE FIRST SEMESTER OF 2018

Milan Bergamo Airport has announced an increase of 5.7% in passenger flow in the first six months of 2018, with a total of 6 million 157 thousand people in transit, allowing the airport to consolidate its third place in the rankings for Italian airports.

This is the result emerging from the traffic data for June, which provide a view of the first six months of the year and allow for forecasts to be made. This is a trend which, if confirmed for the second half of the year, will allow the airport to achieve its goal of 13 million passengers by the end of the year. In 2017, the airport reached a total of 12.3 million passengers.

There are also positive results for freight handling, exceeding 60 thousand tonnes in the first six months of 2018, in line with forecasts, allowing the sector to maintain its strategic value.
