

Vueling returns to Bergamo for the summer season, presenting the route to Barcelona!

The airline once again confirms its presence at Milan Bergamo Airport for the entire 2019 summer season. From 24 July to 27 October, with up to 4 flights per week and 16,500 seats to the Catalan capital.

Milan, 24 April 2019. - Vueling inaugurates the summer season with the **Bergamo-Barcelona route**. Initially proposed exclusively for the Easter holidays, the route run by the airline Vueling will once again be operational from **14 July to 27 October 2019**.

From today, spending a spring weekend of the summer holidays in the Catalan capital is now easier thanks to the route operated by the airline, which is returning to Bergamo to celebrate the beginning of the summer season in the best of ways.

- **October with 3 flights a week** (Mondays, Fridays and Sundays);
