

Vueling launches 28 special flights connecting Bergamo and Barcelona for Easter and the 1 May bank holiday

As of today it is possible to book tickets from the Vueling website for one of the 28 special flights which will be operated by the airline in the period between 12 April and 5 May, with more than 5,000 seats available.

Milan, 23 January 2019 - As of today, Vueling is offering passengers departing from Bergamo tickets for **28 special flights** made available for the Easter holidays and the bank holidays between 25 April and 1 May from **Milan Bergamo airport to Barcelona El Prat**. With these flights, Vueling is offering more than **5,000 seats** available for the Catalan capital from Bergamo in the period between 12 April and 5 May.

The special flights from Bergamo Orio Al Serio are in addition to the regular flights operated by Vueling from **Milan Malpensa** which for next summer will be running up to **6 direct daily flights with more than 440,000 seats available** (an increase of **23%** compared to last summer). The destinations served by Vueling are **Alicante**, with 2 weekly flights, **Amsterdam**, with 7 weekly flights, **Barcelona**, with up to 39 weekly flights, **Bilbao**, with up to 3 weekly flights, **Ibiza**, with up to 12 weekly flights, and **Paris Orly**, with 20 weekly flights.

Thanks to connections to the Barcelona hub, passengers flying from Bergamo and Milan can take advantage of the exclusive **Vueling-to-Vueling connecting flight service**, which permits a single check-in at the departure airport and baggage collection directly at the final destination. Thanks to this service, passengers departing from Italy can have easy access to **more than 120 destinations served by the airline throughout Europe, Africa and the Middle East**.
