



RECIPES FROM PASSENGERS IN MILAN BERGAMO AIRPORT, THE DEADLINE FOR PARTICIPATION IN THE EVENT HAS BEEN EXTENDED TO 30 SEPTEMBER 2019

Another month has been granted for applications to take part in the “**CHEF IN AEROPORTO**” initiative, which is calling for passengers at Milan Bergamo Airport to invent and present a recipe for selection and participation in the cooking show that will take place at the Vicook Bistrot located in the terminal, where they will have the opportunity to prepare their dish **in the presence of the three-star chef Chicco Cerea**.

In response to the success of the initiative and the many applications received, the decision has been made to extend the deadline to **30 September 2019** in order to allow time to prepare the documentation as set out by the regulations.

Adult passengers are invited to create a recipe inspired by the local area, one that represents the homeland of Milan Bergamo Airport and which uses ingredients that are predominantly from the Lombardy region.

All that is required is a ticket for a journey taken or to be taken by 31 December 2019 in order to try your hand at the culinary arts and take part in the “**CHEF IN AEROPORTO**” initiative.

Participants are invited to visit the website www.bgychef.milanbergamoairport.it, enter their personal details together with a copy of their travel ticket, the description of the recipe for a maximum length of 1,500 characters in Italian, and photographs up to 5 MB in size representing the steps of the method (in JPEG, GIF or PNG format).

By 20 October, an expert jury will choose the three best recipes, which will be presented during the cooking show taking place at the Vicook Bistrot, the prestigious restaurant in the airport terminal run by **the three-star chef Chicco Cerea, who will be present and who will accompany the contestants in the final challenge**.

The winner’s recipe will be included for one year in the menu at the Vicook Bistrot, considered to be one of the best airport restaurants in the world.

The initiative is aimed at involving the passengers in the world of wine and food culture that has for some time been a focus of Milan Bergamo Airport, with proposals based on taste experiences and the rediscovery of the local identity.

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
