

Urgent measures to contain and manage the health emergency

To contain the spread of the COVID-19 virus, for those who intend to enter the national territory, **with registered residence in Italy from a date prior to 23 December 2020 or for a reason of absolute necessity proven by self-declaration, and who within fourteen days have stayed or passed through**

UNITED KINGDOM OF GREAT BRITAIN AND NORTHERN IRELAND

ARE STRICTLY REQUIRED TO

- **provide** to the airline at the time of embarkation and to anyone appointed to carry out the checks, the **certification of having undergone, in the 72 hours prior to entry into the national territory, a molecular or antigen test, carried out by means of a swab and resulted negative;**
- **upon arrival, immediately undergo a molecular or antigen test at the airport to be carried out by means of a swab;**
- **undergo, regardless of the outcome of the test carried out at the airport, health surveillance and fiduciary isolation for a period of fourteen days at home or place of stay.**

It is also **mandatory to immediately communicate your entry into the national territory** to the local health authority of reference:

- if you have residence or you are staying in the county of Bergamo, you must inform the **Bergamo ATS Prevention Department;**
- if you have residence or domicile or you are staying in other counties it is necessary to **inform your local health department.**
