### VOLUNTARY OR COMPULSORY PROVISION OF DATA

The provision of data marked with an asterisk (\*) in the form is obligatory for the conclusion and fulfilment of the contract. Refusal to provide the aforementioned information will therefore not permit use of the services.

### SUBJECTS AUTHORISED TO CARRY OUT PROCESSING

The data may be processed by employees of the business functions charged with the fulfilment of the purposes indicated above, who are expressly authorised to carry out processing and have received suitable operating instructions.

### RECIPIENTS OF DATA

The data may be communicated to subjects operating as data controllers (for example supervisory and control authorities and all public entities entitled to request the data) or processed on behalf of the Company by subjects designated as data processors, who have been provided suitable operating instructions (for example companies providing website management and/or maintenance services for the Company; companies offering marketing and communication services; companies offering support for the carrying out of market research). On prior consent, the data may be communicated to third parties operating in the sector.

### RIGHTS OF THE DATA SUBJECT- LODGING OF COMPLAINTS WITH THE SUPERVISORY AUTHORITY

By contacting the Company via email at the address [privacy@sacbo.it](mailto:privacy@sacbo.it), data subjects may ask the Data controller for access to the data concerning them, the erasure of said data, the rectification of incorrect data, the completion of incomplete data, the restriction of processing in the cases provided for by article 18 of the GDPR, as well as object to processing in the legitimate interests of the Data controller for reasons regarding the data subject's particular circumstances.

In the event that processing is based on consent or contract and is carried out with automated tools, data subjects also have the right to receive the data in a structured, commonly used, machine-readable and interoperable format, and, if technically possible, to transmit it to another controller without hindrance.

Data subjects have the right, at any time, to revoke consent granted for marketing purposes as well as to oppose the processing of data for marketing purposes. Data subjects who wish to be contacted for the aforementioned purposes exclusively by traditional means may express their opposition exclusively to the receiving of communications sent by automated means.

Data subjects have the right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority in the Member State in which they habitually reside or work, or in the State in which the alleged infringement has taken place.
