NEW LINK LAUNCHED BETWEEN BERGAMO AND MOSCOW

The inaugural ceremony for the link with Moscow, operated by Pobeda, a low-cost Russian airline from the Aeroflot group, was held on Monday 21 December at the Airport of Milan Bergamo. This launch, which had a trial flight on Sunday 20 December, was celebrated in the check-in area with top SACBO representatives in attendance, as well as diplomatic representatives from Russia, ENAC (Italian Civil Aviation Authority) and other airline associations. These guests watched the cutting of the cake alongside the mayors of Bergamo and Orio al Serio. The arrival of the Pobeda Airlines flight from Moscow was subsequently saluted with the traditional water salute from the Fire Brigade.

This connection between Moscow Vnukovo and the Airport of Milan Bergamo will be operated daily. Pobeda uses next-generation Boeing 737-800s with 189 seats and flies to the airport of Vnukovo, which is located 23 kilometres south of the Russian capital.

The flight will leave Moscow at 13:05 (local time) to arrive in Bergamo at 14:30 and will depart once more at 15:00 to reach its destination at 20:25 (time in Moscow).

Pobeda offers passengers an all-inclusive service on its direct flight to Bergamo, which includes a bus ticket for the 50-minute transfer to Milan's Central Station. Passengers arriving from Bergamo to Moscow can use the Aeroexpress train, which operates from 06:00 to midnight and connects the Vnukovo airport with the capital (Kievsky station) in 35 minutes.
