BGY AIRPORT CONFIRMS ITS PLACE IN THE SKYTRAX TOP TEN

Milan Bergamo Airport confirms its place in the Top Ten best airports in the world which principally handle low-cost airlines.

The annual classification, produced by the specialist company Skytrax as part of their World Airport Awards, hands the 2016 prize to the Tokyo Narita terminal, which leads ahead of T2 Kansai and London Stansted. Bruxelles Charleroi and Berlin Schönefeld are at the foot of the podium. Above them are Kuala Lumpur, London Luton, East Midlands, Frankfurt Hahn and Milan Bergamo.

The Skytrax report is based on over 13 million questionnaires filled out by passengers of over 106 different nationalities in the period from June 2015 to February 2016, and takes into consideration 550 airports selected from all around the world.

The presence of Milan Bergamo Airport is to be considered highly gratifying, as surveying began right after the inauguration of the new wing of the passenger terminal which took place at the end of May 2015. The up-coming inauguration of the area dedicated to gastronomic excellence, already partially open with a number of the most prestigious Italian brands offering tasting and sales, placed in direct contact with gates in the Schengen area, can only increase the level of appreciation for passenger services.
