

MERIDIANA AND SACBO ANNOUNCE THE SUMMER SCHEDULE FROM BERGAMO

14 destinations to meet the holiday requirements of all passengers.

Meridiana and Sacbo, the Milan Bergamo airport management company, are pleased to announce the summer schedule of the operator that, with a renewed partnership between the two companies, will see numerous holiday destinations for 2016 served by the airport, as well as many new routes.

*“The Meridiana summer network from Milan Bergamo is the result of close collaboration with Sacbo - states **Andrea Andorno**, Sales Director of Meridiana - and offers our passengers in north-east Italy a wide choice, to easily reach their favourite holiday destinations. In fact, in addition to the Meridiana long-standing routes from Bergamo to Sardinia and the Red Sea, this summer the company has no fewer than 14 beach destinations, mostly in the Mediterranean, to meet all travel requirements. By connecting Greece, Spain, Sardinia, southern Italy, the Red Sea and Cape Verde, the positioning of the Company as a benchmark carrier for the leisure sector has been reaffirmed”.*

*“The expansion of flights operated by Meridiana from Milan Bergamo airport in the summer operating timetable, which are specifically during the holiday months as they have seaside resorts as their destinations, confirms the trend to promote convenient and advantageous solutions for users - explains **Giacomo Cattaneo**, Aviation Director of SACBO - Meridiana, which traditionally prefers Bergamo airport for its seasonal programme, has developed a number of destinations including authentic pearls of the Mediterranean, while keeping the flights to the Red Sea and to Sal Island in Cape Verde. This is certainly an attractive offering for our passengers, who value the accessibility and services of our airport, such as the Fast Track, the executive lounges and the BGY TOP service, which includes the previous two services with the addition of personalised assistance from arrival at the airport to boarding the aircraft”.*

As for domestic connections, in addition to the weekly flight to **Naples**, which operates all year round and also continues in summer, from 1st June the daily service to **Olbia** resumes, which doubles on Saturdays during peak season, with two flights to the Costa Smeralda. In addition, a totally new route for 2016, Puglia is coming back into the Meridiana summer programme, with a weekly scheduled flight from Bergamo to **Brindisi** on Sundays, which will start on 19th June, to which a second flight also on Sundays has been added, which is reserved exclusively for a charter program.

Greece is central in the network of Meridiana flights from Bergamo. In fact, four Aegean islands are served by weekly links from Milan Bergamo airport: **Mykonos** every Friday from 3rd June and **Rhodes** on Saturdays, while **Kos** starts from 10th June, also on a Friday. Added to these is a charter schedule to **Crete**.

Spain, with the magnificent **Balearic Islands**, will feature equally highly in the Meridiana summer schedule: From 29th May the Bergamo - **Ibiza** route launches, which runs every Sunday, while the weekly flight to **Menorca** will start from 5th June, also on Sundays. **Majorca** will instead have charter flights running throughout the summer. The Canary Islands are also included in the company's summer schedule with a weekly flight between Bergamo and **Fuerteventura**, operating on Mondays from 6th June.

Charter and scheduled flights for the **Red Sea** are also confirmed: **Marsa Alam** runs throughout the summer period while **Sharm El-Sheikh** is until the end of May; the direct route to **Cape Verde** also continues, operated by Meridiana every Saturday between Bergamo and **Sal Island**.
