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Expo Antalya 2016: tickets on sale from the ticket office at Milano Bergamo Airport

Daily flights via Istanbul

Expo 2016, on the theme of *“Children and Flowers”* is in full swing in Antalya, in Turkey, inspired by the philosophy of inviting people to “cultivate a green life for future generations”. History, Bio-Diversity, Sustainability and Green Cities are the four themes of this event which opened on 23 April and which will end on 30 October 2016.

The ticket office at Milano Bergamo Airport is selling tickets for the event, at a cost of 20 euro (reduced to 5 euro for children between the ages of 8 and 13). Admission is free to children under the age of 8 and to individuals with disabilities.

This is the first time that Turkey has hosted an International Exposition. EXPO 2016 Antalya is an invitation to a new way of thinking, characterised by the heady perfume of flowers, the laughter of children and the hope of an ever greener world.

The exposition site is represented by the Expo Tower which reproduces the ancient Roman Hadrian’s Gate, while Efe and Ece are the two mascot children. In the 2016 Expo Area a museum of biodiversity has been created, together with a series of peony-shaped terraces. Antalya, with its Greek-Roman and Byzantine past, is one of the most fascinating destinations in the Mediterranean.

Antalya can be easily reached from Bergamo for a visit to Expo 2016 and to the city with its charming surroundings. The Pegasus Airlines Boeing 737-800 takes off every day at 14:05 for Istanbul, arriving at 17:45 for a stop-over, to then continue with the same airline for Antalya, departing at 19:50 and arriving at 21:15. One single check-in to arrive at the final destination. The return journey is just as easy, departing from Antalya at 8:50 and arriving at 10:05 in Istanbul, to then take off at 11:25 and land at Milano Bergamo Airport at 13:25.
