

SACBO memo on safety standards at Bergamo Airport

Following the press releases issued by the mayors of the municipalities surrounding the airport, with regards to the requests for further information on safety levels at the airport, SACBO feels it is opportune to highlight the following.

The flight-related infrastructures have been designed according the most advanced national and international standards. As part of the extraordinary maintenance works carried out in Spring 2014, the structure of the safety areas located at the end of the runway was further improved, with an increase in dimension, receiving approval and successive certification from ENAC after the carry out of tests.

SACBO, in concentrating on the continuous improvement of flight-related infrastructures in order to consolidate the current safety standards, already of the highest levels, has programmed investment of approximately 30 million euro for the installation of specific innovative technology as part of the new Airport Development Plan.

Bergamo Airport therefore aims to become the first airport in Italy to adopt the most advanced solutions of this kind.
