SACBO Board of Directors approves new environmental mitigation works for 4.5 million

The SACBO Board of Directors has examined and has unanimously decided to adopt further mitigation measures in the areas surrounding the airport grounds, thus responding to requests from Council representatives of the Municipality and Province of Bergamo.

Specifically, 4.5 million euros have been allocated to fund new mitigation works on approximately 250 private habitations, in addition to the sum of 3 million which has already been designated for measures currently in the executive planning phase to be carried out on approximately 170 habitations located in the municipalities of Orio al Serio, Grassobbio, Seriate and Bagnatica. This is the most significant investment in mitigation works made by SACBO to date, and joins the 2.5 million spent in 2013 on 9 schools and 125 habitations, bringing the total amount invested to 10 million.

SACBO will begin contacting the Municipal Administrations involved in the new allocation of mitigation funds, in order to indicate the areas which have been identified for the carrying out of this next wave of works and the criteria that led to their selection.
