



U.S. delegation visits the Bergamo Airport

SACBO, the management company of the Bergamo Airport, welcomed an American delegation made up of institutional representatives from the counties of Arlington, Connecticut and Washington, Maryland. Among these were workers from agencies for economic promotion and management professionals. Led by Confindustria Bergamo, they visited the most important institutions in the territory of Bergamo.

The delegation was promoted by Marazzi & Advisors in partnership with Lang Strategies, chaired by Barbara Bryant Lang, who has been president of the Chamber of Commerce of Washington County for 14 years, and is currently on the board of the Washington Reagan and **Dulles** airports.

The delegation was received by Emilio Bellingardi, SACBO's managing director, and Giacomo Cattaneo, aviation director. They demonstrated how far the Bergamo Airport has arrived in the context of national and European air transportation, and the airport's strategic function in mobility within Lombardy, serving as a catchment area reaching the neighbouring regions as well.
