MILAN BERGAMO AIRPORT NUMBER ONE FOR PUNCTUALITY

Milan Bergamo Airport confirms its position as the number one airport in Italy for punctuality. This position has been assigned by OAG, Air Travel Intelligence, an English agency which analyses the results and performance of the aeronautic world on a global level, including all of the entities involved, from airlines to airports, from travel agents and tour operators to companies offering services connected to air transportation. In its evaluations, OAG takes into consideration over 900 airlines and 4,000 airports among the most important worldwide with a significant operative level.

When it was part of the category of airports with a movement of up to 10 million passengers, Milan Bergamo Airport held seventh place on a global scale in terms of punctuality, with 86.9% in the report produced in 2016, referring to the previous year. With the change in category which took place in 2016 with the exceeding of the 10 million passenger quota, OAG placed Milan Bergamo Airport 23rd overall, with 85.87%, based on traditional criteria for evaluation, which take into account the percentage of flights that operate within 15 minutes of the scheduled time. In a more recent report, produced with the use of supplementary analytical criteria, OAG attributed Milan Bergamo Airport with 85.4% punctuality with regards to the 69,619 passenger flights, placing it 60th on a global scale, and confirming the best performance on a national level.

OAG has assigned three stars to Milan Bergamo Airport (part of the group of airports with a punctuality index of between 83 and 87.8%) on a scale which includes five stars (for a dozen airports with punctuality of 90% and over) and four stars (between 88 and 90%).
