ERNEST AIRLINES MAKES ITS DEBUT AT MILAN BERGAMO AIRPORT

On 6th June, Milan Bergamo Airport welcomed the inaugural flight of Ernest Airlines, the new Italian airline previously known as "Fly Ernest", which made its debut at Bergamo airport with a route to Tirana.

The arrival of the Ernest Airlines Airbus A319 was welcomed at midday by the traditional water salute carried out by the Orio al Serio Fire Brigade. Immediately after the arrival on the stand, the ribbon-cutting ceremony took place in the presence of Alfredo Sostero, the Account Manager of Ernest Airlines, and Giacomo Cattaneo, Director of Aviation at SACBO. The ceremony was repeated at the boarding gate for the first flight departing for Tirana operated by Ernest Airlines.

Ernest Airlines flights between Milan Bergamo Airport and Tirana will take place on a twice-weekly basis (Tuesdays and Saturdays) in the first two weeks of June, with the addition of Fridays from the third week of June onwards. From 10th July to 9th September, the number of weekly flights will increase to 4, with the addition of Wednesdays, to then return to the three-flights-per-week schedule.
